The first is proposed for Sat afternoon 15<sup>th</sup> Sep. (13:00ish) at Wiper and True's Brewery on York Street, St Werburgs (Bus 5), weather permitting as it's outdoors. Probably followed by another BBQ at HBK's, also weather permitting. The second proposed Brewery Tap session would be on Sat 27<sup>th</sup> Oct, similar time at the Bristol Beer Factory's Taproom on North Street, Bedminster/Southville (Bus 24), but this time weather independent as it's indoors.

Xmas meal, HBK, Booked for Sat 15<sup>th</sup> Dec, 14:30 at the Kensington arms after a Saturday 11:00 hash from somewhere near, hare needed. More details and booking forms/menu choices soon, deposits will be required.
